GAME DAY

The Colgate Raiders take a four-game winning streak on the road this Saturday, when the Raiders (5-2 overall, 1-0 Patriot League) travel to Bucknell (4-2, 1-0 PL) for a Patriot League game at Christy Mathewson-Memorial Stadium. Kickoff is 1:10 p.m.

College football coaches across the nation will be celebrating "Coach to Cure Muscular Dystrophy" day. Colgate head coach **Dick Biddle**, along with other coaches across the nation, will be wearing arm bands to show their support for the program.

A victory in Saturday's game would assure Colgate its 12th winning season in 13 years under Biddle.

THE SERIES

This is the 57th meeting between Colgate and Bucknell with the Raiders leading the overall series, 40-16. These two teams have split their last four outings with Colgate winning last year, 28-24. The Bison have defeated the Raiders in the last two games played in Lewisburg.

COLGATE RECEIVING VOTES

Colgate is receiving votes in both The Sports Network FCS Poll and FCS Coaches Poll.

COLGATE VS. PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS UNDER BIDDLE

In the last 13 seasons, the Raiders are 58-16 against Patriot League teams under head coach **Dick Biddle** for a winning percentage of .783. They have lost to Lehigh six times, Bucknell four times, Holy Cross three, Fordham twice and Lafayette once.

COLGATE HEAD COACH

Colgate head coach **Dick Biddle** is in his 13th season with the Raiders. He has an overall record of 100-48 for a .675 winning percentage. In 2003, he was named the American Football Coaches Association Division I-AA National Coach of the Year, and three times in his career he has been Patriot League Coach of the Year.

His Patriot League and overall winning percentage is the highest of any coach who has coached eight or more seasons in the league.

Biddle is the first Colgate coach to post 10 straight winning seasons (1996-2005) and the first Colgate coach to record nine straight seasons with seven or more victories (1997-2005). He has won seven or more games in 10 of his 12 seasons with the Raiders.

BIDDLE WINS 100TH GAME

Dick Biddle is the winningest football coach in the 118 years of Colgate football with 100 victories.

Biddle owns the Patriot League records for wins in league games (58) and overall victories (100).

DICK BIDDLE COACHES SHOW

The **Dick Biddle Coaches Show** is held every other Thursday at the Colgate Inn throughout the season from 7-8 p.m. The show is carried by WKXZ Radio (93.9 FM). The next show is this ewThursday, Oct. 23.

SCOTT ON WALTER PAYTON WATCH LIST

For the second straight season, **Jordan Scott** has been named to the Walter Payton Award watch list. The award goes to the outstanding player in the Football Championship Subdivision.

NATION'S LEADING RUSHER

Jordan Scott, who led the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) last season in rushing with 170.45 yards per game, is again leading the FCS this season with 161.8 yards per game. He is tied for fourth scoring with 11.0 points per game and 10th in all-purpose running (168.8 yards per game).

SCOTT APPROACHING ELITE COMPANY

Jordan Scott needs 29 yards to join only seven other FCS runners with four consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons, joining Jerry Azumah of New Hampshire, Adrian Peterson of Georgia Southern, Alonzo Coleman of Hampton, Clifton Dawson of Harvard, Steve Baylark of Massachusetts, Scott Phaydavong of Drake and Donald Chapman of Tennessee-Martin.

SCOTT IS ALL-TIME RUSHING LEADER

Jordan Scott is the school's all-time rushing leader with 5,444 yards. He has passed Colgate's two former Walter Payton Award winners to the top of the list. Scott is also the Patriot League's all-time leading rusher.

SCOTT BREAKS FCS CAREER CARRIES RECORD

Jordan Scott has broken the FCS record for career carries with 1,189. He needs 26 carries to break the all-time NCAA Division I record held by Steve Bartalo of Colorado State and 82 carries to break the all-division mark of 1,271 set last year by Division II Northwest Missouri State's Xavier Omon.

FCS CAREER RUSHING

Jordan Scott is currently in sixth place in FCS career rushing with 5,444 yards. He needs 46 yards for fifth place.

SCOTT IN THE STARTING LINEUP

With **Jordan Scott** in the starting lineup, Colgate is 21-8 when he gains 100 or more yards, and 2-6 when he doesn't. The Raiders are 6-2 when he gains 200 yards or more.

100-YARD RUSHING GAMES

Jordan Scott has rushed for over 100 yards in 29 games tying the school record. He holds the school & Patriot League record for consecutive 100-yard games with 18.

SCOTT THIRD IN SCORING

Jordan Scott is currently in third place in career scoring with 334 points. He needs nine points for second place and 17 for first place.

SCOTT SECOND IN CAREER RUSHING TD'S

Jordan Scott is second in career rushing touchdowns with 53, trailing all-time leader Kenny Gamble, who had 55.

SECOND BEST RUSHING PERFORMANCE

Jordan Scott's 272 yards rushing against Fordham was the second best single game performance in school history. He has four of Colgate's top 10 single-game rushing performances.

SCOTT HAS TWO-GAME RUSHING RECORD

Jordan Scott has broken his own Colgate mark for most rushing yardage gained in two consecutive games with 511. He had 239 against Dartmouth and 272 against Fordham. The old mark was 462.

SCOTT IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

Jordan Scott is the Patriot League's all-time rusher (5,444) and scorer (334). He also holds the record for consecutive 100-yard rushing games (18), total 100-yard games (29), 200-yard games (8) and career carries (1,189).

SIMONDS PUTS UP IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS

Junior wide receiver **Pat Simonds** continued his outstanding season last Saturday against Cornell. After catching a career-high 11 passes for 152 yards against Princeton, Simonds had five catches for a career-high 196 yards against the Big Red. His 196 receiving yards was the fourth highest total in school history. In the last two games, he has caught 16 passes for 348 yards.

MOVING UP THE CHART

Pat Simonds is currently 12th on Colgate's career receiving yardage list with 1,378 yards. He needs 75 yards for 11th place. Simonds is currently eighth in the nation (FCS) with 104.14 yards per game.

BACK-TO-BACK 100

Sophomore **Greg Sullivan** became only the third quarterback in school history to rush for over 100 yards in back-to-back games. He had 136 yards against Dartmouth and 107 against Fordham.

The other quarterbacks to accomplish the feat are **Ryan Vena** once in 1998, and **Tom Parr** three times during his career (1971-73).

EACHUS CRACKS TOP TEN

Freshman running back **Nate Eachus** had the eighth best single game rushing performance in school history last Saturday against Cornell. In the third quarter, he carried 37 times for 241 yards and three touchdowns.

THIRD IN THE NATION

Colgate's rushing offense currently ranks as the third best in the FCS. The Raiders are averaging 271.2 yards per game. They are 14th overall in total offense.

TOUGH AGAINST THE RUSH

In the last 13 seasons, the Raiders have held the opposition to less than 100 yards rushing 60 times, and are 56-4 when doing so.

COLGATE NOTEBOOK (vs. Cornell)

Nate Eachus racked up the most rushing yardage by a Colgate back in the 91-game history in the series against the Big Red ... He was named Patriot League Rookie of the Week ... Sophomore quarterback **Greg Sullivan** threw for a career-high 225 yards ... his 78-yard TD pass to **Pat Simonds** was the eighth longest in school history ... Simonds finished with a career-high 196 yards receiving - fourth highest single game total ever in school history ... on five catches, Simonds averaged 39.2 yards per reception breaking the school record for highest average gain per reception for a minimum of three catches ... **David Morgan** had his first career interception, while **Chris Ekpo** came down with his second ... Ekpo had a team-high 12 tackles, caused one fumble, had two pass breakups, and one TFL ... **Brendan Buglione** had a fumble recovery ... Colgate's 600 yards of total offense was the highest total since the Buffalo game in 2003, when the Raiders had 621 yards ... The 600 yards was the ninth highest in school history ... The Raiders finished 3-0 against the Ivies.

ON DEFENSE

Junior linebacker **Greg Hadley** is Colgate's leading tackler with 42 followed by freshman linebacker **Mike Carbone** with 41 and defensive back **Uzi Idah** with 40. Junior defensive tackle **Carlton Walker** has a team-high eight tackles for minus yardage and three quarterback sacks.

IN THE RED ZONE

Through the first seven games, Colgate has had a .897 percent success rate in the red zone, scoring on 26 of 29 opportunities.

COLGATE CAPTAINS

Colgate captains are senior tailback **Jordan Scott**, senior quarterback **Alex Relph** and senior offensive tackle **Nick Hennessey**.

COLGATE PLAYERS TABBED WITH PRESEASON HONORS

Jordan Scott was tabbed a preseason FCS All-America by The Sporting News; second team preseason All-America by Consensus Draft Services; and third team preseason by College Sporting News.

Phil Steele's Football Magazine named offensive tackle **Nick Hennessey** second team preseason All-America, while he joined Scott, offensive tackle **Steve Jonas** and defensive back **Wayne Moten** on the Patriot League preseason first team. Wide receiver **Pat Simonds**, offensive guard **Rich Rosabella**, defensive tackle **Paul Mancuso** and defensive back **Mike Barry** were second team selections.

Hennessey was also named second team All-America by The Sports Network.

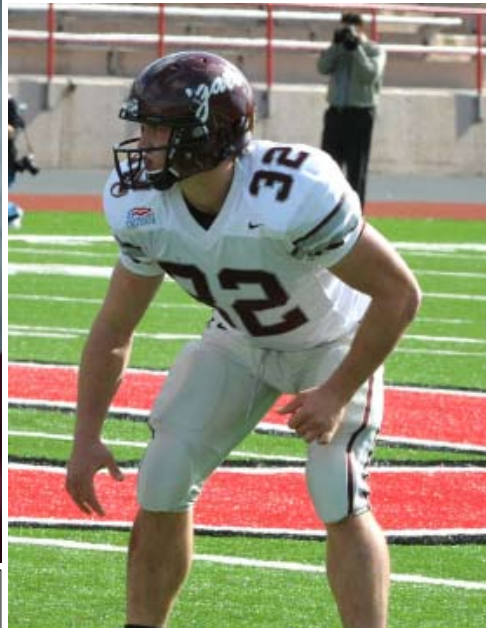
