GAME DAY

The #21 ranked Colgate Raiders (8-2 overall, 4-0 Patriot League) will be playing host to the Holy Cross Crusaders (7-3, PL 5-0) this Saturday in a battle for the Patriot League Championship at Andy Kerr Stadium. Kickoff is 1:06 p.m.

The winner of Saturday's game takes the 2008 title and receives an automatic berth in the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision playoffs.

The Raiders, who are seeking their sixth Patriot League title under head coach Dick Biddle, have won seven straight, while Holy Cross has a six-game winning streak.

THE SERIES

This is the 71st meeting between Colgate and Holy Cross with the Crusaders leading the overall series, 37-28-5. Last season, Holy Cross snapped a six-game losing streak to the Raiders with a 27-20 win at Fitton Field. The Crusaders are 13-11-3 on Colgate's home field, but have dropped the last three at Andy Kerr Stadium.

Tickets for the Colgate-Holy Cross game are available at the Raider Ticket Office (315-228-7600). They are priced at \$15 for reserved seats, \$10.00 for general admission, and \$5.00 for children (12 and under) in the general admission section.

COLGATE IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

Colgate is ranked #21 in The Sports Network Poll, #22 in the FCS Coaches Poll, and #18 in the SME Network Poll.

COLGATE VS. PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS UNDER BIDDLE

In 13 seasons under head coach **Dick Biddle**, the Raiders are 61-16 against Patriot League teams for a winning percentage of .792. They have lost to Lehigh six times, Bucknell four times, Holy Cross three, Fordham twice and Lafayette once.

COLGATE HEAD COACH

Colgate head coach **Dick Biddle**, who is in his 13th season with the Raiders, is the winningest football coach in school history with 103 victories. He overall winning percentage (.682) and Patriot League winning percentage (.792) is the highest of any coach who has coached eight or more seasons in the league. He also owns the Patriot League records for wins in league games (61) and overall victories (103).

In 2003, he was named the American Football Coaches Association Division I-AA National Coach of the Year, and he has been Patriot League Coach of the Year three times in his career.

Biddle was the first Colgate coach to post 10 straight winning seasons (1996-2005) and the first Colgate coach to record nine straight seasons with seven or more victories (1997-2005). He has won seven or more games in 11 of his 13 seasons with the Raiders, and eight or more games in six seasons.

DICK BIDDLE COACHES SHOW

The **Dick Biddle Coaches Show** is held every other Thursday at the Colgate Inn throughout the season from 7-8 p.m. The show is carried by WKXZ Radio (93.9 FM). The next show is on Thursday, Nov. 20.

CARDIAC KIDS

Colgate has won six games this season in the final quarter, and three in the final minutes. Against Coastal Carolina (final play), Dartmouth (two fourth quarter TD's), Fordham (nine seconds left), Princeton (two seconds left), Lafayette (two fourth quarter TD's) and Lehigh (TD with 2:28 remaining).

SCOTT ON WALTER PAYTON WATCH LIST

For the second straight season, **Jordan Scott** has been named to the Walter Payton Award watch list. The award goes to the outstanding player in the Football Championship Subdivision.

COLGATE'S LEADING RUSHER

Jordan Scott is leading Colgate in rushing with 138.86 yards per game. Scott, who was injured in the second quarter of the Cornell game, has carried only twice since sustaining the injury. Scott led the FCS last season in rushing with 170.45 yards per game.

SCOTT APPROACHING ELITE COMPANY

Jordan Scott needs 28 yards to join only five other FCS runners with four consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons, joining Jerry Azumah of New Hampshire, Adrian Peterson of Georgia Southern, Alonzo Coleman of Hampton, Scott Phaydavong of Drake and Donald Chapman of Tennessee-Martin.

SCOTT IS COLGATE'S AND PATRIOT LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME RUSHING LEADER

Jordan Scott is Colgate's and Patriot League's all-time rushing leader with 5,445 yards. He has passed Colgate's two former Walter Payton Award winners to the top of the list.

SCOTT BREAKS FCS CAREER CARRIES RECORD

Jordan Scott has broken the FCS record for career carries with 1,191. He needs 24 carries to break the all-time NCAA Division I record held by Steve Bartalo of Colorado State and 80 carries to break the all-division mark of 1,271 set last year by Division II Northwest Missouri State's Xavier Omon.

FCS CAREER RUSHING

Jordan Scott is currently in sixth place in FCS career rushing with 5,445 yards. He needs 45 yards for fifth place.

SCOTT IN THE STARTING LINEUP

With **Jordan Scott** in the starting lineup, Colgate is 21-8 when he gains 100 or more yards, and 2-6 when he doesn't. The Raiders are 6-2 when he gains 200 yards or more.

100-YARD RUSHING GAMES

Jordan Scott has rushed for over 100 yards in 29 games tying the school record. He holds the school & Patriot League record for consecutive 100-yard games with 18.

SCOTT THIRD IN SCORING

Jordan Scott is currently in third place in career scoring with 334 points. He needs nine points for second place and 17 for first place.

SCOTT SECOND IN CAREER RUSHING TD'S

Jordan Scott is second in career rushing touchdowns with 53, trailing all-time leader Kenny Gamble, who had 55.

SECOND BEST RUSHING PERFORMANCE

Jordan Scott's 272 yards rushing against Fordham was the second best single game performance in school history. He has four of Colgate's top 10 single-game rushing performances.

SCOTT HAS TWO-GAME RUSHING RECORD

Jordan Scott broke his own Colgate mark for most rushing yardage gained in two consecutive games with 511. He had 239 against Dartmouth and 272 against Fordham. The old mark was 462.

SCOTT IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

Jordan Scott is the Patriot League's all-time rusher (5,445) and scorer (334). He also holds the record for consecutive 100-yard rushing games (18), total 100-yard games (29), 200-yard games (8) and career carries (1,191).

FOUR IN TEN

In four of Colgate's ten games this season, the Raiders have had a 200-yard rusher. Jordan Scott went back-to-back against Dartmouth (239) and Fordham (272), while freshman Nate Eachus duplicated the feat against

Cornell (241) and Bucknell (214).

MOVING UP THE CHART

Pat Simonds is currently 11th on Colgate's career receiving yardage list with 1,609 yards. He needs two yards for 10th place, 48 for ninth place and 72 for eighth place. Simonds has caught a pass in 21 straight games.

Against Lehigh, Simonds tied the school record for touchdown catches in a game with three.

1,000 YARD SEASON

Pat Simonds needs 40 receiving yards to become the fifth player in school history with 1,000 yards receiving in a season. He has caught 55 passes for 960 yards and six touchdowns.

He also needs two catches and two yards to crack Colgate's Top 10 list in catches per game and receiving yards in a season.

BACK-TO-BACK QUARTERBACK 100'S

Sophomore **Greg Sullivan** became only the third quarterback in school history to rush for over 100 yards in back-to-back games. He had 136 yards against Dartmouth and 107 against Fordham.

The other quarterbacks to accomplish the feat are **Ryan Vena** once in 1998, and **Tom Parr** three times during his career (1971-73).

QUARTERBACK SINGLE-SEASON RUSHING MARK

Greg Sullivan needs 44 rushing yards to break the single-season school record for rushing yardage by a quarterback. The old mark is held by Tom Parr with 833 yards during the 1973 season when Colgate was running the wishbone.

EACHUS CRACKS TOP TEN

Freshman running back **Nate Eachus** had the eighth best single game rushing performance in school history with his performance against Cornell. In the three quarters, he carried 37 times for 241 yards and three touchdowns.

EACHUS GOING FOR 1,000

Nate Eachus needs 246 yards to become only the second freshman in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season.

THIRD IN THE NATION

Colgate's rushing offense currently ranks as the third best in the FCS. The Raiders are averaging 283.22 yards per game.

Colgate is 12th overall in total offense, averaging 424.44 yards per game.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Colgate has won 61 of its last 77 Patriot League games.
- Colgate has won 25 of its last 38 games decided by nine points or less.

TOUGH AGAINST THE RUSH

In the last 13 seasons, the Raiders have held the opposition to less than 100 yards rushing 62 times, and are 58-4 when doing so. They have done it three times this season - Dartmouth (91), Lafayette (97) and Lehigh (60).

ON DEFENSE

Junior linebacker **Greg Hadley** is Colgate's leading tackler with 66 followed by freshman linebacker **Mike Carbone** with 57 and junior safety **Uzi Idah** with 54. Sophomore **Zach Smith** and junior **Austin Douglas** are tied for the leadership in quarterback sacks with five apiece, while junior **Carlton Walker** leads in tackles for losses with 10, and junior **Wayne Moten** in interceptions with two.

IN THE RED ZONE

Colgate has had a .884 percent success rate in the red zone, scoring on 38 of 43 opportunities.
