First Round**

### GAME DAY

The #16 ranked Colgate Raiders (9-2) will open first round action in the NCAA FCS Division I Championship on Saturday, when the Raiders travel to #6 Villanova (9-2). Kickoff is 1 p.m. at Villanova Stadium.

Colgate, which won the Patriot League championship, comes into the game riding an eight-game winning streak, while the Wildcats have taken four straight.

### THE SERIES

This is the fifth meeting between Colgate and Villanova with the Wildcats leading the overall series, 3-1, including three straight wins. These two teams have met once before in the NCAA playoffs with Villanova winning 49-28 in 1997. Colgate's only victory in the series was the first meeting in 1978, 20-14.

### NCAA APPEARANCES

Colgate is making its eighth appearance in the playoffs, and first since the 2005 season. The Raiders received the Patriot League's automatic berth after defeating Holy Cross 28-27 Saturday for the league's championship.

### COLGATE IN THE NATIONAL POLLS

Colgate is ranked #16 in The Sports Network and FCS Coaches Polls.

### COLGATE VS. TOP 25 TEAMS

Colgate is 7-8 in its last 15 games against teams ranked in the Top 25 of the FCS. In 2003, they defeated #24 Lehigh, #19 Fordham, #5 Massachusetts, #10 Western Illinois, and #13 Florida Atlantic, before losing to #3 Delaware in the FCS championship game.

Colgate lost to #14 Massachusetts in the 2004 season opener and later to #12 Lehigh. In 2005, they beat #15 UMass 17-14, and lost to #16 Lehigh 50-34 and #1 New Hampshire 55-21. In 2006, they lost to #10 UMass 28-7 and last year to #2 UMass, 35-17. This season the Raiders were defeated by #23 Furman 42-21 and beat #21 Lafayette, 21-13.

### BIDDLE NAMED PL COACH OF THE YEAR

Dick Biddle has earned his fourth Coach of the Year honor after leading Colgate to its sixth Patriot League title in his 13-year tenure, and the first for the Raiders since 2005. The fourth Coach of the Year honor ties him for the most in Patriot League history. Biddle is also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award given to the Coach of the Year in the FCS.

### EACHUS NAMED PL ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

Nate Eachus has been named the Patriot League's Rookie of the Year, and is the fifth Colgate player to earn the honor. He came on late in the season

## COLGATE HEAD COACH

Colgate head coach **Dick Biddle**, who is in his 13th season with the Raiders, is the winningest football coach in school history with 104 victories. His overall winning percentage (.684) and Patriot League winning percentage (.792) is the highest of any coach who has coached eight or more seasons in the Patriot League. He also owns the Patriot League records for wins in league games (62) and overall victories (104).

In 2003, he was named the American Football Coaches Association Division I-AA National Coach of the Year, and he has been Patriot League Coach of the Year three times in his career.

Biddle was the first Colgate coach to post 10 straight winning seasons (1996-2005) and the first Colgate coach to record nine straight seasons with seven or more victories (1997-2005). He has won seven or more games in 11 of his 13 seasons with the Raiders, and nine or more games in four seasons.

## CARDIAC KIDS

Colgate has won seven games this season in the final quarter, and three in the final minutes. Against Coastal Carolina (final play), Dartmouth (two fourth quarter TD's), Fordham (nine seconds left), Princeton (two seconds left), Lafayette (two fourth quarter TD's), Lehigh (TD with 2:28 remaining) and Holy Cross (one fourth quarter TD).

## COLGATE'S LEADING RUSHER

**Jordan Scott** is leading Colgate in rushing with 131.8 yards per game.

## SCOTT APPROACHING ELITE COMPANY

**Jordan Scott** has become only the sixth runner with four consecutive 1,000-yard rushing seasons in FCS history, joining Jerry Azumah of New Hampshire, Adrian Peterson of Georgia Southern, Alonzo Coleman of Hampton, Scott Phaydavong of Drake and Donald Chapman of Tennessee-Martin.

## SCOTT FIFTH IN FCS CAREER RUSHING

## SCOTT IS COLGATE'S AND PATRIOT LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME RUSHING LEADER

## SCOTT IS THE ALL-TIME FCS CAREER CARRIES LEADER

**Jordan Scott** has broken the FCS record for career carries with 1,213. He needs three carries to break the all-time NCAA Division I record held by Steve Bartalo of Colorado State (1,215) and 58 carries to break the all-division mark of 1,271 set last year by Division II Northwest Missouri State's Xavier Omon.

### SCOTT IN THE STARTING LINEUP

With **Jordan Scott** in the starting lineup, Colgate is 21-8 when he gains 100 or more yards, and 3-6 when he doesn't. The Raiders are 6-2 when he gains 200 yards or more.

### 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES

**Jordan Scott** has rushed for over 100 yards in 29 games tying the school record. He holds the school & Patriot League record for consecutive 100-yard games with 18.

### SCOTT THIRD IN SCORING

**Jordan Scott** is currently in third place in career scoring with 340 points. He needs three points for second place and 11 for first place.

### SCOTT SECOND IN CAREER RUSHING TD'S

**Jordan Scott** is second in career rushing touchdowns with 54, trailing all-time leader Kenny Gamble, who had 55.

### SECOND BEST RUSHING PERFORMANCE

**Jordan Scott's** 272 yards rushing against Fordham was the second best single game performance in school history. He has four of Colgate's top 10 single-game rushing performances.

### SCOTT HAS TWO-GAME RUSHING RECORD

**Jordan Scott** broke his own Colgate mark for most rushing yardage gained in two consecutive games with 511. He had 239 against Dartmouth and 272 against Fordham. The old mark was 462.

## SCOTT IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

**Jordan Scott** is the Patriot League's all-time rusher (5,527) and scorer (340). He also holds the record for consecutive 100-yard rushing games (18), total 100-yard games (29), 200-yard games (8) and career carries (1,191).

## FOUR IN ELEVEN

In four of Colgate's 11 games this season, the Raiders have had a 200-yard rusher. Jordan Scott went back-to-back against Dartmouth (239) and Fordham (272), while freshman Nate Eachus duplicated the feat against Cornell (241) and Bucknell (214).

## MOVING UP THE CHART

**Pat Simonds** is currently 8th on Colgate's career receiving yardage list with 1,703 yards. He has caught a pass in 22 straight games.

## 1,000 YARD SEASON

**Pat Simonds** became the fifth player in school history with 1,000 receiving yards in a season. He has caught 59 passes for 1,054 yards and eight touchdowns.

His 59 catches ranks 10th on the single season list and his 1,054 yards ranks as the sixth best season total.

## BACK-TO-BACK QUARTERBACK 100'S

Sophomore **Greg Sullivan** became only the third quarterback in school history to rush for over 100 yards in back-to-back games. He had 136 yards against Dartmouth and 107 against Fordham.

The other quarterbacks to accomplish the feat are **Ryan Vena** once in 1998, and **Tom Parr** three times during his career (1971-73).

## QUARTERBACK SINGLE-SEASON RUSHING MARK

**Greg Sullivan** has broken the single-season school record for rushing yardage by a quarterback with 865 yards. The old mark was held by Tom Parr with 833 yards during the 1973 season when Colgate was running the wishbone.

## FIVE STRAIGHT FOR EACHUS

Freshman **Nate Eachus** has rushed for over 100 yards in five straight games. On the season, he has carried 162 times for 872 yards and 10 touchdowns. All but 25 yards has come in the last five outings.

## EACHUS GOING FOR 1,000

**Nate Eachus** needs 128 yards to become only the second freshman in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season.

## THIRD IN THE NATION

Colgate's rushing offense currently ranks as the fifth best in the FCS. The Raiders are averaging 273.36 yards per game.

Colgate is 13th overall in total offense, averaging 420.45 yards per game.

## TOUGH AGAINST THE RUSH

In the last 13 seasons, the Raiders have held the opposition to less than 100 yards rushing 63 times, and are 59-4 when doing so. They have done it three times this season - Dartmouth (91), Lafayette (97), Lehigh (60) and Holy Cross (19).

## ON DEFENSE

Junior linebacker **Greg Hadley** is Colgate's leading tackler with 70 followed by freshman linebacker **Mike Carbone** with 59 and junior safety **Uzi Idah** with 55. Junior defensive tackle **Austin Douglas** is the leader in quarterback sacks with six, while junior defensive tackle **Carlton Walker** leads in tackles for losses with 10, and junior cornerback **Wayne Moten** in interceptions with three.

## IN THE RED ZONE

Colgate has had a .854 percent success rate in the red zone, scoring on 41 of 48 opportunities.
