#3 Colgate Hosts #6 Lafayette on Wednesday In Quarterfinal Round of Patriot League Tourney

The Colgate men's basketball team (16-13, PL 7-7) is seeded third in the 2008 Patriot League Tournament that gets underway on Wednesday, March 5. The Raiders will host sixth-seeded Lafayette College (15-14, PL 6-8) in a quarterfinal round contest at Cotterell Court. Tip-off is 7:05 p.m.

The other quarterfinal round games are top-seeded American (18-11, PL 10-4) hosting Holy Cross (15-13, PL 5-9); second-seeded Navy (16-13, PL 9-5) entertaining seventh-seeded Bucknell (11-18, PL 6-8); and fourth-seeded Lehigh (14-14, PL 7-7) entertaining fifth-seeded Army (13-15, PL 6-8). The winner of the Colgate-Lafayette game will play the winner of the Navy-Bucknell contest on Sunday, March 9 at a site TBA.

The Colgate-Lafayette game will be televised live back to the Easton, Pennsylvania area by RCN. The game can be heard on WKXZ radio (94 FM) and available through the facilities of TeamLine for listeners outside of the area. Live video is available over the internet as part of the Patriot League's All-Access Pass: www.patriotleague.com.

Colgate is riding a four-game win streak with victories over Lehigh (71-63), North Carolina Central (77-69), Holy Cross (63-55) and Navy (73-62). Lafayette comes into Wednesday's playoff game with a two-game losing streak. The Leopards have lost to Army (65-60) and American (84-72).

This is the 81st meeting between Colgate and American with the Raiders leading the overall series, 43-37. These two rivals split their home-and-home series this season with the Leopards winning in overtime, 69-68, in Hamilton, and Colgate taking a 76-75 decision in Easton, PA. Lafayette has won three straight at Cotterell Court.

In the first meeting this season, Bilal Abdullah scored a game-high 18 points, including the game-winning basket with 3.5 second left in overtime, to lift Lafayette to a win over Colgate. Other top scorers for Lafayette were Andrew Brown with 13 points and Matt Betley with nine. Kendall Chones (Cleveland, OH) had nine points and seven rebounds, while Peter Minchella (West Lafayette, IN) added eight points and five rebounds for the Raiders.

In the second outing, Tim Pounds (Dudley, NC) scored 18 points, including the game-winning free throw with 20 seconds left, as Colgate won at the Kirby Sports Center. Other Colgate players in double figures were Chones with 17 points, Kyle Roemer (Martinez, CA) and Daniel Waddy (Tucson, AZ) with 12 apiece and Mike Venezia (Westfield, NJ) with 10. Betley led Lafayette with 15 points, followed by Michael Gruner with 13 and Everest Schmidt with 12.

Roemer, who was named second team all-Patriot League on Monday, is Colgate's leading scorer with 15.3 points per game which is sixth best in the league. He has been Colgate's top scorer in 17 of 29 games and has a streak of 12 straight games in double figures.

Other top scorers for the Raiders are Chones with 12.0 points per game followed by Waddy with 8.3 ppg and Venezia with 8.2 ppg. Venezia was the top scoring rookie in league play this season and was named to the league's all-rookie team.

Woodhouse is the team's leading rebounder (6.1 pg) and shot blocker (58). He ranks third in the Patriot League in rebounding and second in blocked shots.

In the latest Patriot League statistics, Colgate is third in scoring (66.2), first in field goal percentage (.444) and third in 3-point field goal percentage (.380). The Raiders also ranked third in field goal percentage defense (.412) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (.340) and second in blocked shots (3.83 pg).

Lafayette is led in scoring by Andrew Brown with 16.0 points per game followed by Abdullah (14.7) and Betley (11.4). In the rebounding department, Betley is leading with 5.8 boards per game, followed by Abdullah with 5.3 caroms per outing.

The Leopards are second in league scoring (74.9), third in field goal percentage (.441), third in 3-point field goal percentage (.380) and fifth in free throw percentage (.699). They are eighth in field goal percentage defense (.441) and sixth in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.361).

COLGATE HEAD COACH EMMETT DAVIS

Colgate head coach Emmett Davis is in his 10th season at Colgate. He is currently second on the school's all-time win list with 136 victories.

Kendall Chones has moved into 24th place on Colgate's all-time scoring list with 1,051 points ... Chones has nine straight games in double figures, while Roemer has posted 12 straight ... Roemer is currently in fourth place with 183 career 3-pointers. He needs two more for third place all-time ... Roemer has broken his personal best for 3-pointers in a season with 74 - 5th best single season total in school history. He is 27th in career scoring with 1022 points ... Woodhouse has the 7th best single-season performance for blocked shot with a career-high 58. He is second in the Patriot League in this category ... Colgate is seeking its 17th win of the season which would be the most since the Raiders posted 17 during the 2001-02 season.

Jan. 16 at Hamilton, N.Y. Lafayette 69, Colgate 68 OT

Bilal Abdullah scored a game-high 18 points including the game-winning basket with 3.5 seconds left in overtime to lift Lafayette to a 69-68 win Colgate at Cotterell Court.

Lafayette won for the third straight season on Colgate's home floor.

Other top scorers for Lafayette were Andrew Brown with 13 points and Matt Betley with nine. Colgate was led by Kyle Roemer and Daniel Waddy with 16 points apiece. Kendall Chones had nine points and seven rebounds, while Peter Minchella added eight points and five rebounds for the Raiders.

In overtime, Colgate scored the first basket before Lafayette tallied six straight for a 65-61 lead. Waddy nailed a 3-pointer and Minchella made two free throws with 1:52 left to give Colgate a 66-65 lead. Brown made two free throws with one minute remaining to put the visitors back in front, 67-66, before Minchella hit two more free throws for a 68-67 with 22 seconds left. Lafayette came down the court, and Michael Gruner missed a layup, but Abdullah went high to tip in the rebound for the winning score.

Colgate jumped out to an early 9-3 lead in the first half, before Lafayette rallied to tie the contest 16-16 with 11:39 remaining. The Raiders regained a 3-point lead 19-16 on Minchella's old-fashion 3-point play. With Colgate leading, 23-22, the Leopards scored on a basket by Jeff Kari to take the lead before extending its advantage to 32-25 at halftime.

In the second half, Colgate fell behind by as many as 10 points, 57-47, with 6:08 remaining. The Raiders, however, scored eight straight points to trail by two with 2:51 left. Lafayette continued to lead by two points, 59-57, with 38 seconds left before Colgate sent the game into overtime on Chones' layup with one second left.
